ESPEN aims to stimulate and facilitate innovative research that covers all aspects of nutrition and metabolism. Mastering novel methods and techniques and enhancing collaborative work are determinants of success in nutrition research. Therefore, 5 grants up to 10000€ for eligible initiatives that focus on exchange of scientific and/or technical knowledge will be made available.

Criteria:

- ESPEN membership is a requirement for both the applicant and the principal investigator at the host institution.
- Funding is intended to support the acquisition of novel research methods, techniques, or data analysis approaches at a department or laboratory external to the applicant's own institution.
- Novel method, techniques and/or data analysis approach must be available at institution of grantee
- One proposal per institution
- Max 2 grantees per host institution
- Visit at host institution must occur within one year after receiving the grant
- Within 3 months after the research visit, a summary report must be submitted to the ESPEN Scientific Committee
